**AUSTIN** -- The sixth annual Texas Community Music Festival will be held April 29 - May 11, 2011 in Austin, and promises to be the most diverse and eclectic community music festival ever, with groups ranging in size from trios to “renegade marching bands” to symphonic bands of 60 pieces or more, featuring everything from world beat music to jazz to R&B to Highland pipes and drums.

Since its inception in 2006, nearly 50,000 music lovers have enjoyed the spectacular Austin spring weather and five lively music festivals, held at venues throughout “the live music capital of the world,” Austin, Texas.

The 2011 TCMF continues the tradition, as performances will run for 10 days: Friday - Tuesday, April 29-May 3 and Saturday-Tuesday, May 7-10, at HEB Central Market North, and Wednesday May 4 and May 11 at the Park at the Triangle, during the Triangle Farmer’s Market.
